2010-11 RMAC MEN'S GOLF NEWS & NOTES

ADAMS STATE COLLEGE

Team Notes: The Grizzlies started their first season under coach Justin Palermo by hosting the Grizzly Invitational. The tournament was a dual with Mesa State contested under a Ryder Cup Format. The teams battled in a series of four-ball match play matches on Tuesday morning and afternoon before contesting six singles matches on Wednesday. The Grizzlies scored a half-point in each of the three sessions. Seniors Ross Benson (Scottsdale, Ariz.) and Mic Davis (Rye, Colo.) helped earn two half-points each while freshman John Gorrell (Colorado Springs, Colo.) helped earn a half-point as well. Benson and Davis teamed together in Tuesday morning's four-ball half-point as they finished all square with Mesa State's Jake Jacobs and Jeb Savage in the No. 1 match. That afternoon, Benson and Gorell matched Eric Farmer and Jake Jacobs in the No. 1 match. On Wednesday, Davis finished all-square with Jacobs in the No. 5 singles match. Although the match-play results were official in determining the official team and individual champions, all players did complete every hole for NCAA qualifying purposes. Benson carded the best three rounds of his Grizzly career finishing with a 69, 72 and 71. Those scores also allowed him to better his best tournament score by an impressive 10 strokes. His total score of 212 would have placed him second in the tournament. Davis also posted the best three rounds of his Grizzly career finishing with scores of 80, 83 and 77. Palermo had two true freshman and two others also making their Grizzly debuts in his 6-man lineup. Gorell, a Sand Creek High School product, and Niko Mircos of Longmont High School were the freshman. Junior Josh Crow (Eads, Colo.) and sophomore Jimmy Hood (Alamosa, Colo.) both redshirted last season.

Bingaman shot the only tournament's eagle and led the tourney with 11 birdies and 38 pars. Three Mavericks posted 3-0 Ryder Cup records. MSC shot under 300 (285, 290, 286-861) for the first time in school history. The ASC Grizzly Invite was the first tournament under new coach Paul Brown.
