RMAC MEN'S SWIMMER OF THE WEEK

At the Tri-Meet with Mesa State and Pacific, Ivarsson placed first in all four of his events. He competed in the 100 back (56.93) and 500 Free (4:54.70). He also swam a split time of 49.16 in the 400 Free Relay and a split time of 56.09 in the 400 Medley Relay. Ivarsson made his NCAA automatic qualifying times in the 100 and 200 Back. His swimming times rank him eighth and fifth in Division II for the 100 Back (50.74) and 200 Back (1:50.52), and first in the RMAC in those two events. At the Finis Collegiate Invite, Ivarsson finished fourth in the 100 back and second in the 200 back of the prelims. In the 200 and 400 free relay, he swam a split time of 20.65 and 45.50. In addition, he also competed in the 200 and 400 medley relays and swam split times of 24.35 and 51.63. He competed in the 100 free and finished in a time of 46.83, which was a NCAA B Cut.

Hoffman placed first in all four of her events at the GCU meet with Mesa State and Pacific University on Jan. 2. She won the 100 backstroke (1:01.89), 200 backstroke (2:12.24), 400 IM (4:46.96) and the 400 medley relay (1:02.45 split). At the Finis Collegiate Invite in Long Beach Dec. 11-14, Hoffman made one A cut and three B cuts. Her A cut came on the last day of the meet in the 200 backstroke with a time of 2:04.30, placing her fifth overall. She recorded B cut times in the 100 backstroke (:58.79), the 400 IM (4:35.50), and the 200 IM (2:10.40). She also competed in three relay events, with her team finishing fourth in the 400 medley (58.59 split), sixth in the 200 medley (28.50 split), and she swam a 2:00.35 split in the non-scoring 800 free relay.

RMAC Men's Swimmer of the Week

Teams Notes: The men's team made eight NCAA cuts at the meet. They had two individuals, Artem Tretiakov and Johan Ivarsson, make A cuts. Tretiakov made an A cut in the 100 Free while Ivarsson made A cuts in the 100 and 200 Back. In addition, both swimmers also made B cuts. Tretiakov's B cut was in the 50 and 200 Free events and Ivarsson's B cut was in the 100 Free. Fellow teammates Charles Woodruff made a B cut in the 50 Free and Richard Krzyzanowski made a B cut in the 200 Fly. Incarnate Word's next meet will be a Tri-Meet at California San Diego.

MESA STATE COLLEGE

Top Swimmer: Dan MacDonald (Freshman, Gillette, Wyo. / Campbell County HS)

At the Grand Canyon Invitational, MacDonald won the 100-yard butterfly in 54.47 seconds. He placed second in the 100-yard freestyle (51.09) and third in the 50-yard freestyle (22.91). In the 400-yard Medley Relay, MacDonald and his teammates placed third in a time of 3:51.91.

Team Notes: Dan MacDonald led the Mesa State men's swim team to a 101-76 win over Pacific and lost to No. 22 ranked Grand Canyon 178-51 last Saturday. Pahler placed second in the 200-yard breaststroke (2:28.51), third in the 200-yard freestyle (1:56.00) and fourth in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:08.53). Justin Skall placed second in the 1000 freestyle in a time of 11:43.29 and third in the 500-yard freestyle (5:42.85). Eric Flemming finished second in the 200-yard butterfly (2:22.51). The Mavs will host the Mesa State Duals on Jan. 16. This dual meet will be Mesa's first home event in the new Natatorium.

Top Swimmer: *Caiti Hoffman (Sophomore, Gilbert, Ariz./Gilbert HS)*

RMAC Women's Swimmer of the Week

Team Notes: Grand Canyon's duals with Mesa State (W, 174-51) and Pacific (W, 185-38) were their first ever dual meet wins. At the Finis Collegiate Invite, they combined to make 12 NCAA qualifying times, with Hoffman accounting for four of them. Alexis Glessner also made four B cuts (500, 1000, 1650 free, 100 fly). Also making a B cut at the meet were Riley Smith (400 IM), Julie Redaway (100 breaststroke), Brooke Bellah (100 freestyle), and Tori Heron (1650 free).

MESA STATE COLLEGE

Top Swimmer: *Katie Wedel (Sophomore, Pueblo, Colo. / Pueblo South HS)*

Wedel finished first in the 200-yard breaststroke at the Grand Canyon Invitational in a time of 2:23.08. She finished second in the 200-yard butterfly (2:17.98) and third in the 400-yard IM (4:49.23). Wedel was also part of the 400-yard medley relay that placed second (4:12.05).

Team Notes: Mesa State women's swim team, ranked #19 in the latest poll, defeated Pacific University 221-20, but fell to host #21 Grand Canyon 177-85 in Phoenix Saturday afternoon. Sophomore standout Katie Wedel won the 200-yard breaststroke in a time of 2:34.08 followed by teammate Denby Gardiner's second place finish (2:39.72). Wedel placed second in the 200-yard butterfly (2:17.98) and third in the 400-yard IM (4:49.23). Gardiner took second in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:12.54). Sophomore Gina Panacci took second place in the 1,000 freestyle in a time of 11:32.35. Panacci placed third in the 500-yard freestyle (5:40.77). The relay team of Panacci, Rachel Bailey, Jordan McMillen and Gardiner finished third in the 400-yard freestyle relay. Jaclyn McMillen, Wedel, Kelly Hogan and Rebecca Reed placed second in the 400-yard medley relay in a time of 4:12.05. Hogan finished third in the 200-yard freestyle (2:00.16). Jaclyn McMillen was second in the 200-yard backstroke (2:12.36) and finished third in the 100-yard backstroke (1:03.84). The Mavs will host the Mesa State College Duals Saturday January 16 in its first home event in the new MSC Natatorium.

MINNESOTA STATE UNIVERSITY-MOORHEAD

Top Swimmer: *Cassie Jensen (Senior, Jamestown, N.D./Jamestown HS)*

Jensen had impressive performances in both winter break competitions. Jensen swam career bests in four events and finished fourth overall in the pentathlon competition versus Northern State on Dec. 31. Jensen's times in the 50 butterfly (27.90), 50 backstroke (33.85), 50 breaststroke (34.49), and 100 IM (1:09.54), along with her pentathlon total time of 3:14.08, were all lifetime bests. Jensen also swam a 1:13.08, just a half-second off her lifetime best in the 100 breaststroke at the 40-degree outdoor meet in Tampa relay meet on Jan. 6.

Team Notes: Against Northern State on Dec. 31, each swimmer competed in five events: 50-yard Butterfly, 50-yard Backstroke 50-yard Breaststroke 50-yard Freestyle and the 100-yard Individual Medley. The times from the five events were added together to decide the individual champion. Ann Gusewelle was the individual pentathlon champion with a total time of 184.21 seconds. NSU's Christine Retzlaff finished second with 187.11. Dragon swimmers Karena King, Cassie Jensen, and Olivia Martin rounded out the top five. Gusewelle had the fastest times in the 50 Breaststroke (31.47), 100 IM (64.90), and 50 Freestyle (26.97). Jensen had the fastest time in the 50 Butterfly (27.90.50) breaking a school pentathlon record and Retzlaff had the fastest time in the 50 Backstroke (31.61). On Jan. 6 at the Tampa Relays, the Dragons took second place in five races and third in four relays. The second place finishes included the 800-yard freestyle, 300-yard breaststroke, 400-yard medley, 200-yard freestyle and 500-yard freestyle scramble. In the 800-yard freestyle, the Dragons were led off by Jessica Doar, followed by Olivia Martin and Jessy Belden and anchored by Jess Tauber. The four finished the relay in 8:39.68. Dragons' top swimmer, Ann Gusewelle led the team in the 300-yard breaststroke, followed by Cassie Jensen and Kelsey Meyer to finish in 3:41.20. Justine Turk led Gusewelle, Claire Caron and Karena King to a second place finish in the 400-yard medley, where the group finished in 4:26.34. Tauber, Gusewelle, King and Martin were four seconds shy of Tampa in the 200-free to finish second in a time of 1:50.71. Heather Harris, Martin and Doar finished the 500-yard freestyle relay in a time of 5:59.46.

NORTHERN STATE UNIVERSITY

Top Swimmer: *Christine Retzlaff (Sophomore, Wahpeton, N.D. / Wahpeton HS)*

On Jan. 1 at the MSU Moorhead Pentathlon, Retzlaff finished second in the pentathlon, including the top time in the 50-yard backstroke with her time of 31.61. She finished fourth in the 50-yard butterfly with a time of 28.87, and she also finished second in the 100-yard IM with her time of 65.37. She added a second place finish in the 50-yard breaststroke with a time of 33.90 and a second place finish in the 50-yard freestyle with a time of 27.36. Retzlaff was part of a the first place 200-yard medley relay squad that broke the Northern State school record with their time of 1:58.96 at their dual against Concordia College in Aberdeen, S.D. on Dec. 11. The sophomore finished first in all four events she competed. Retzlaff also competed in the 100-yard backstroke (1:04.51), the 100-yard fly (1:01.32), and the 200-yard IM (2:17.71). She accumulated a total of 27 individual points and 38 overall points for the Wolves.
