2010-11 RMAC WOMEN'S GOLF NEWS & NOTES

ADAMS STATE COLLEGE

Top Golfer: Kelsey McSpadden (Junior, Dumas, Texas)

McSpadden posted a career best round of 79 helping her to a career-best 2-day score of 165 and the team to single-round and tournament score school-records as the Grizzly Invitational on Tuesday and Wednesday. After carding an 86 to stand in 17th place after Tuesday's round, McSpadden came back with her career-round to move all the way up into a tie for 10th place. She now has placed in the top 10 in four of her last six tournaments and has six overall top 10 finishes, tied for second most in school-history.

Team Notes: Led by McSpadden (see above) and senior Codi Hegg (Colorado Springs, Colo.), career best rounds of 79, the Grizzlies combined for a school-record team score of 325 on Wednesday. The mark was a full 7-shot betterment of their former record of 332 set at last October's Regis Invitational. The Grizzlies also had a school-record 2-day total of 664, a full seven shots better than the 671 set at the same tournament. The team's first day score of 339 was tied for the sixth best in school history at the time and now stands tied for seventh best in school history. The Grizzlies had been in fifth place after the first day but moved up two spots to third after Wednesday's record setting round. McSpadden and Hegg's rounds marked the first time in school history that the Grizzlies had two players break 80 in the same season, let alone the same day. Those two scores are now tied for the fifth best single-round scores in school history. McSpadden's 2-day total of 165 was a 7-shot improvement over her former 2-day best of 172, set at the Quality Inn Spring Maverick Invitational as a freshman in Grand Junction on Apr. 13-14, 2009. All five Grizzlies had their scores figured into the team score at least once as the whole squad finished within seven shots of each other. Through one tournament, the Grizzlies have a 3-1 head-to-head record against teams in the RMAC and the Central Region. They are 3-2 overall.

CHADRON STATE COLLEGE

Team Notes: The Eagles started their season Sept. 7-8 at the MSUB Yellowjacket Invite and finished third with a score of 713. CSC was led by Emilee Pilkington who shot a 173 (87-86).

COLORADO CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY

Team Notes: Colorado Christian finished sixth out of six teams at the ASC Grizzly Invite. Ashley Olsen paced the Cougars with a 15th place finish (tie) and a score of 168.

COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY - PUEBLO

Team Notes: Michaela Brett shot a 163 at the ASC Grizzly Invite to pace the Pack to a fourth place team finish. CSUP shot a two round score of 666 in the six team tournament.

Team Notes: The Mavericks won the Grizzly Invitational by 35 strokes. Three players shot rounds in the 70's on the final day (Jessica Berve, 75; Jennifer Hilts, 74; Michelle Stripp, 76). Three Mavericks also finished 1-2-3 (tied for third) in the six team, 29 individual field. Michelle Stripp, who tied for third place, was the only player in the field to register an eagle. All four Maverick players shot at least one round in the 70's.
